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October 2015 ECC/ILCOR updates on PAD programs:

It is now highly recommended that PAD programs for patients with out-of-hospital cardiac arrest (OHCA) be implemented in communities at risk for cardiac arrest. Studies have validated better outcomes in communities with PAD programs. Communities with best practice PAD programs have survival rates that exceed 60%–70%, with some even approaching 90%. ¹

Also, given the low risk of harm and the potential benefit of any social media that summons rescuers via an app or cell phone/text message, it may be reasonable for communities to incorporate, where available, social media technologies to summon rescuers who are willing and able to perform CPR or locate the nearest AED to a suspected victim of OHCA. ¹
